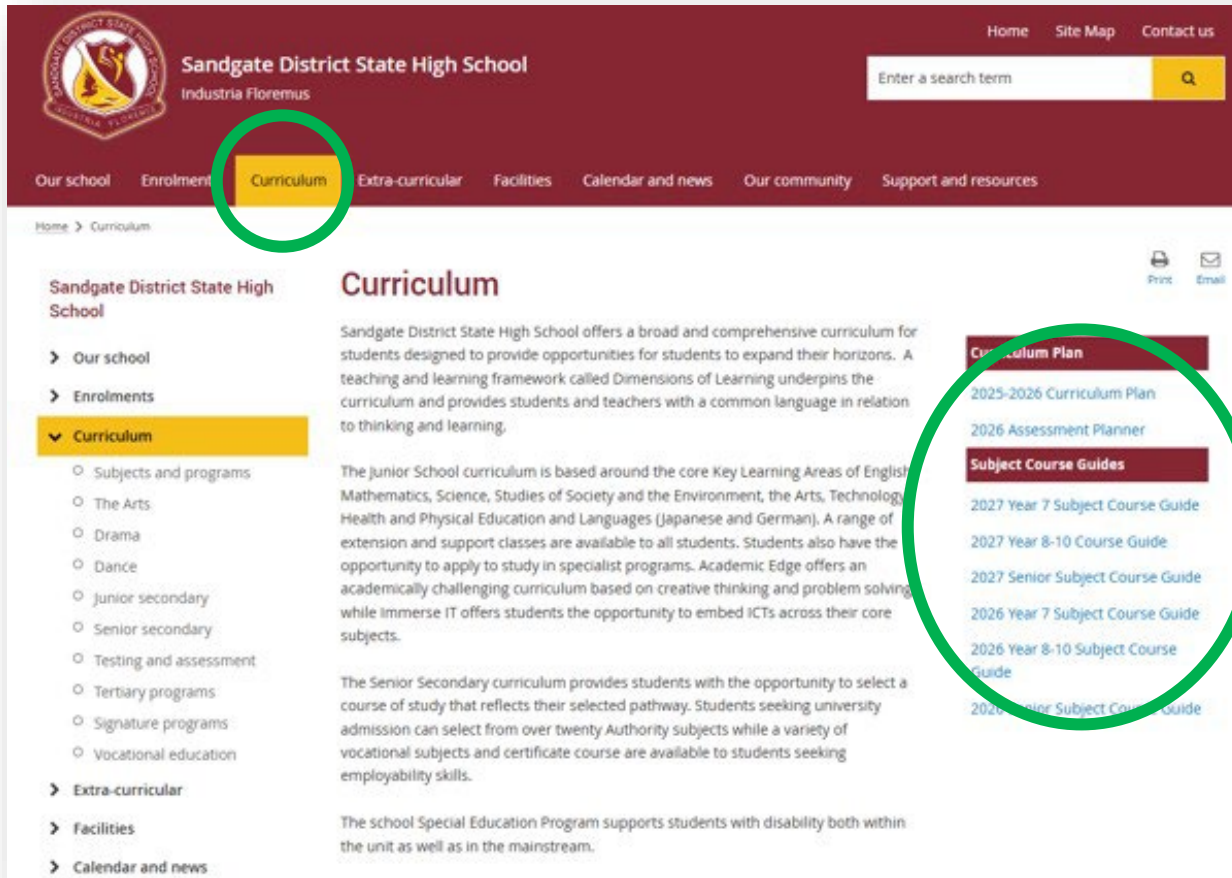

Curriculum

Sandgate District State High School offers a broad and comprehensive curriculum for students designed to provide opportunities for students to expand their horizons. A teaching and learning framework called Dimensions of Learning underpins the curriculum and provides students and teachers with a common language in relation to thinking and learning.

The Junior School curriculum is based around the core Key Learning Areas of English, Mathematics, Science, Studies of Society and the Environment, the Arts, Technology, Health and Physical Education and Languages (Japanese and German). A range of extension and support classes are available to all students. Students also have the opportunity to apply to study in specialist programs. Academic Edge offers an academically challenging curriculum based on creative thinking and problem solving while immerse IT offers students the opportunity to embed ICTs across their core subjects.

The Senior Secondary curriculum provides students with the opportunity to select a course of study that reflects their selected pathway. Students seeking university admission can select from over twenty Authority subjects while a variety of vocational subjects and certificate course are available to students seeking employability skills.

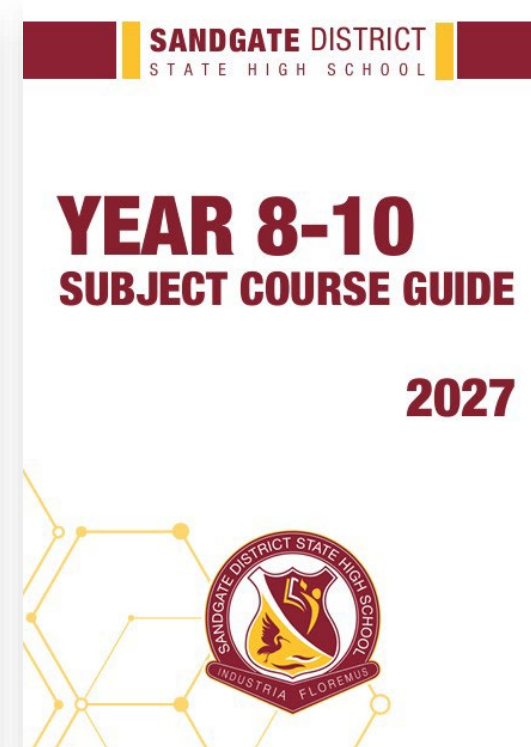
The school Special Education Program supports students with disability both within the unit as well as in the mainstream.

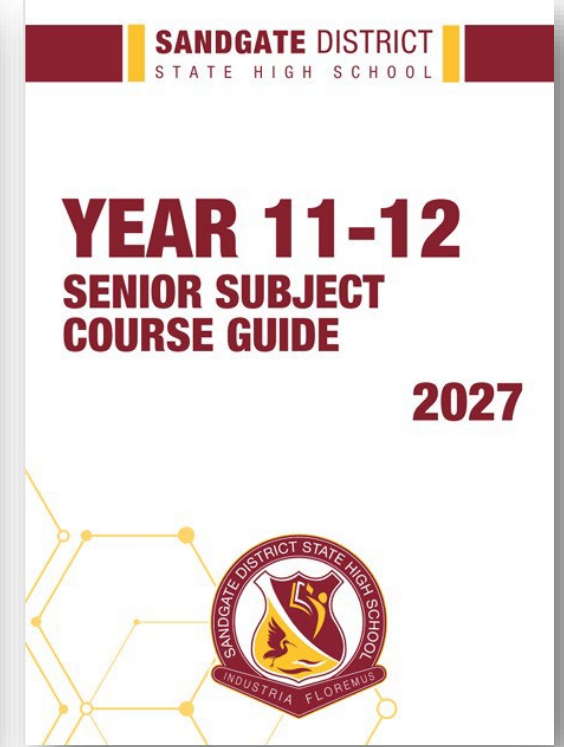

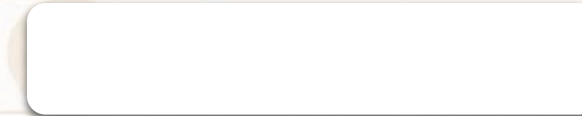

- The Careers Expo is held in Term 2 Year 10. This comprises of subject stalls, external providers, University, TAFE, senior schooling information and more.
- Compulsory attendance for all year 10 students and a least one parent or carer.
- **Semester 1 results determine eligibility for entry into senior subjects.**
- SET Plan interviews take place in Term 3 week 2 and 3. Compulsory attendance for students and at least one parent or carer. Preparation will be completed in Connect lessons.
- Preparation - Attend TAFE university open days.
- Read the newsletter for school-based opportunities.
- Very important to pass Semester 1 English and Maths

Study at Home Policy

As a general guide, students should aim to complete the following amount of homework for each subject, each week:

- **Year 7 - 45 minutes**
- **Year 8 - 1 hour**
- **Year 9 - 1 – 1.5 hours**
- **Year 10 - 1.5 hours**
- **Year 11 - 2 – 2.5 hours** (depending on course of study)
- **Year 12 - 3 hours** (depending on course of study)

Can look like:

- Daily independent reading
- Extension of classwork
- Assignment segments over a course of weeks
- Revision through QLearn or similar programs provided by school
- Pre-reading following days work or chapter
- Re-reading over your notes from each day

Ensure that you:

- Have a dedicated, well-lit and quiet space to work
- Plan assignment segments to work on at home
- Complete drafts by the due date
- Apply draft feedback for your final assessment
- Complete all assessment by the due date
- Engage with quizzes and revision set in online platforms

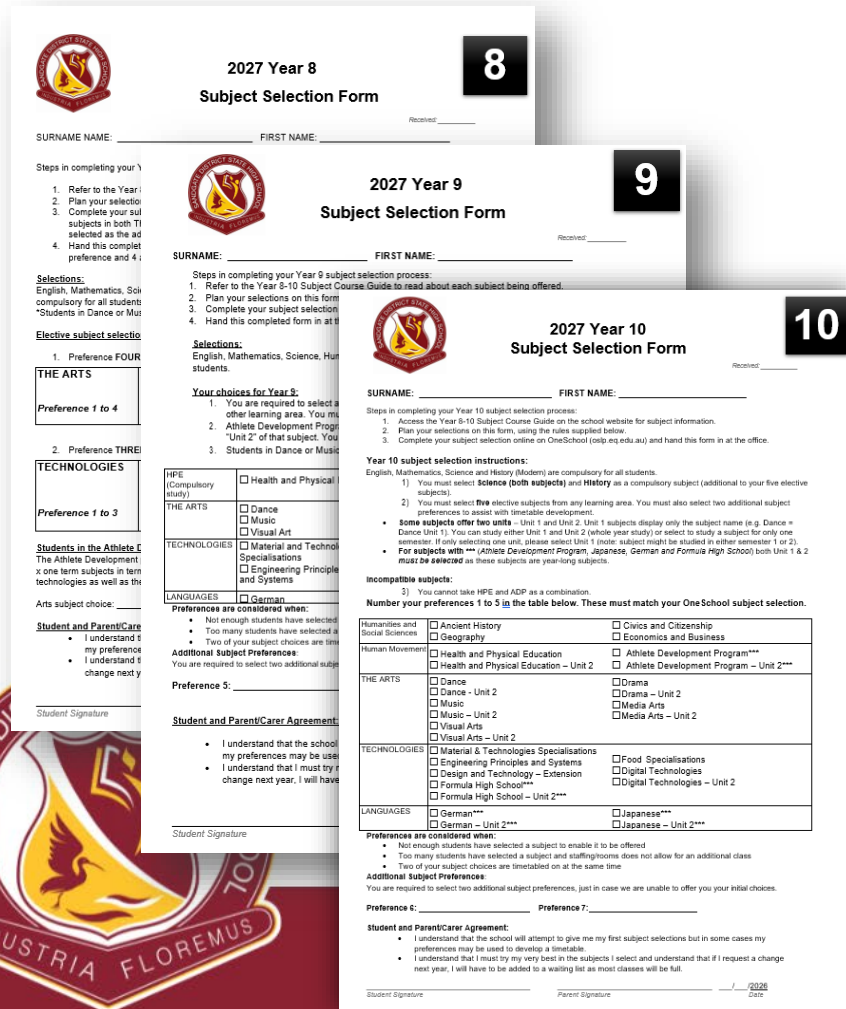
Process for Subject Selection

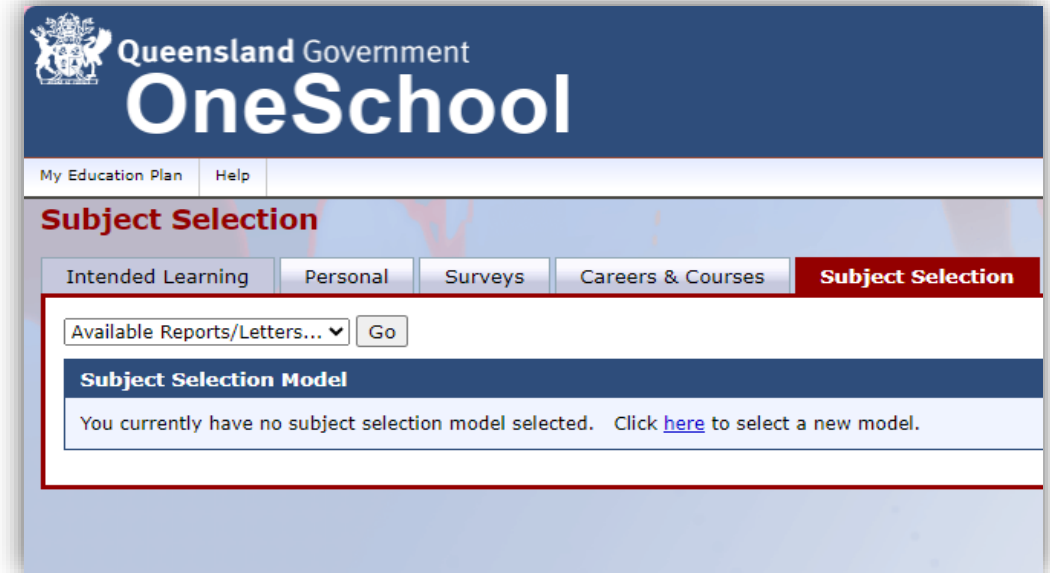

Sandgate District State High School offers a broad and comprehensive curriculum for students designed to provide opportunities for students to expand their horizons. A teaching and learning framework called Dimensions of Learning underpins the curriculum and provides students and teachers with a common language in relation to thinking and learning.

The Junior School curriculum is based around the core Key Learning Areas of English, Mathematics, Science, Studies of Society and the Environment, the Arts, Technology, Health and Physical Education and Languages (Japanese and German). A range of extension and support classes are available to all students. Students also have the opportunity to apply to study in specialist programs. Academic Edge offers an academically challenging curriculum based on creative thinking and problem solving while immerse IT offers students the opportunity to embed ICTs across their core subjects.

The Senior Secondary curriculum provides students with the opportunity to select a course of study that reflects their selected pathway. Students seeking university admission can select from over twenty Authority subjects while a variety of vocational subjects and certificate course are available to students seeking employability skills.

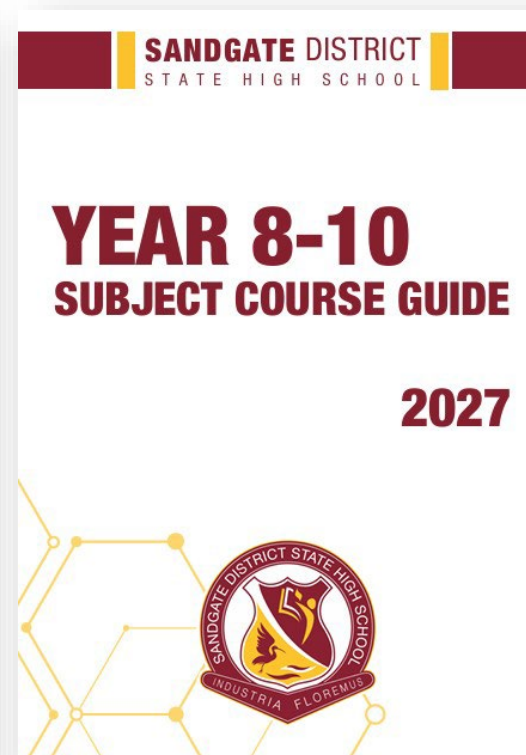
The school Special Education Program supports students with disability both within the unit as well as in the mainstream.

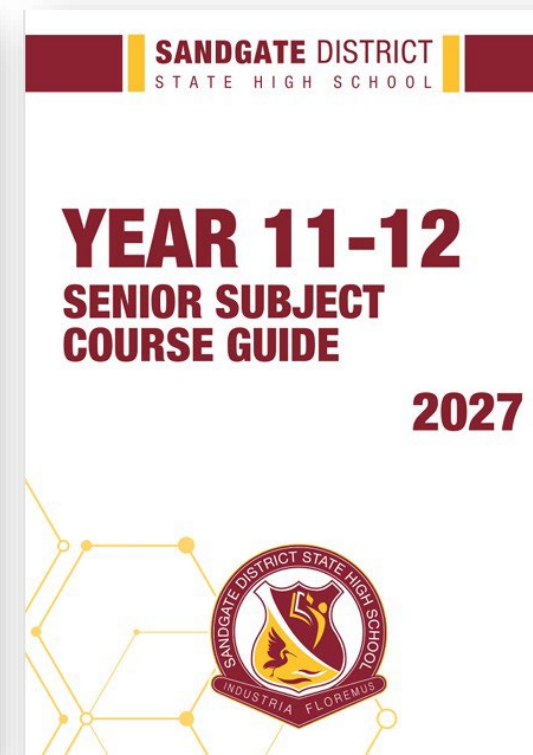
