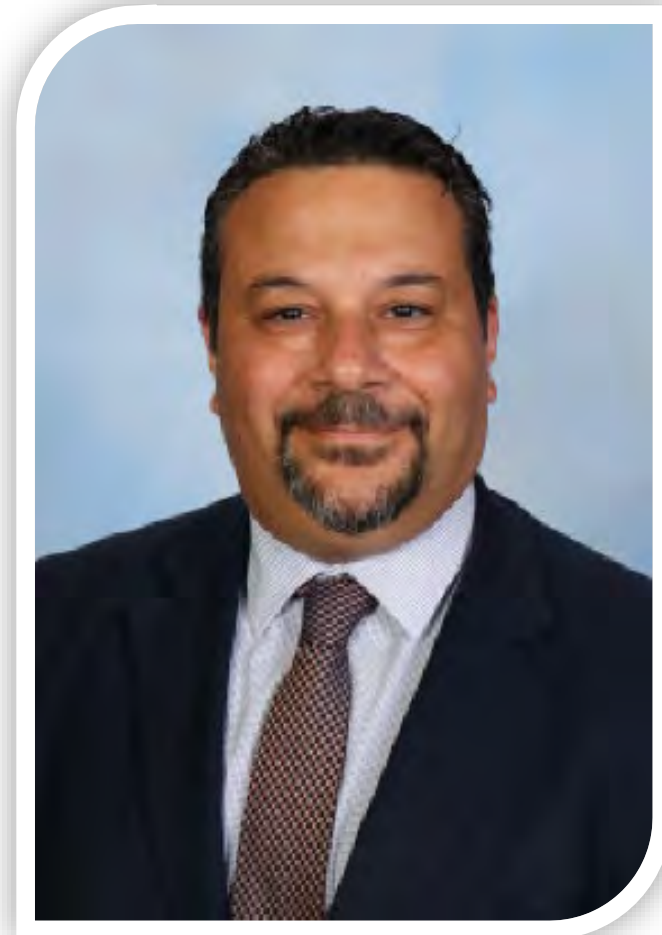

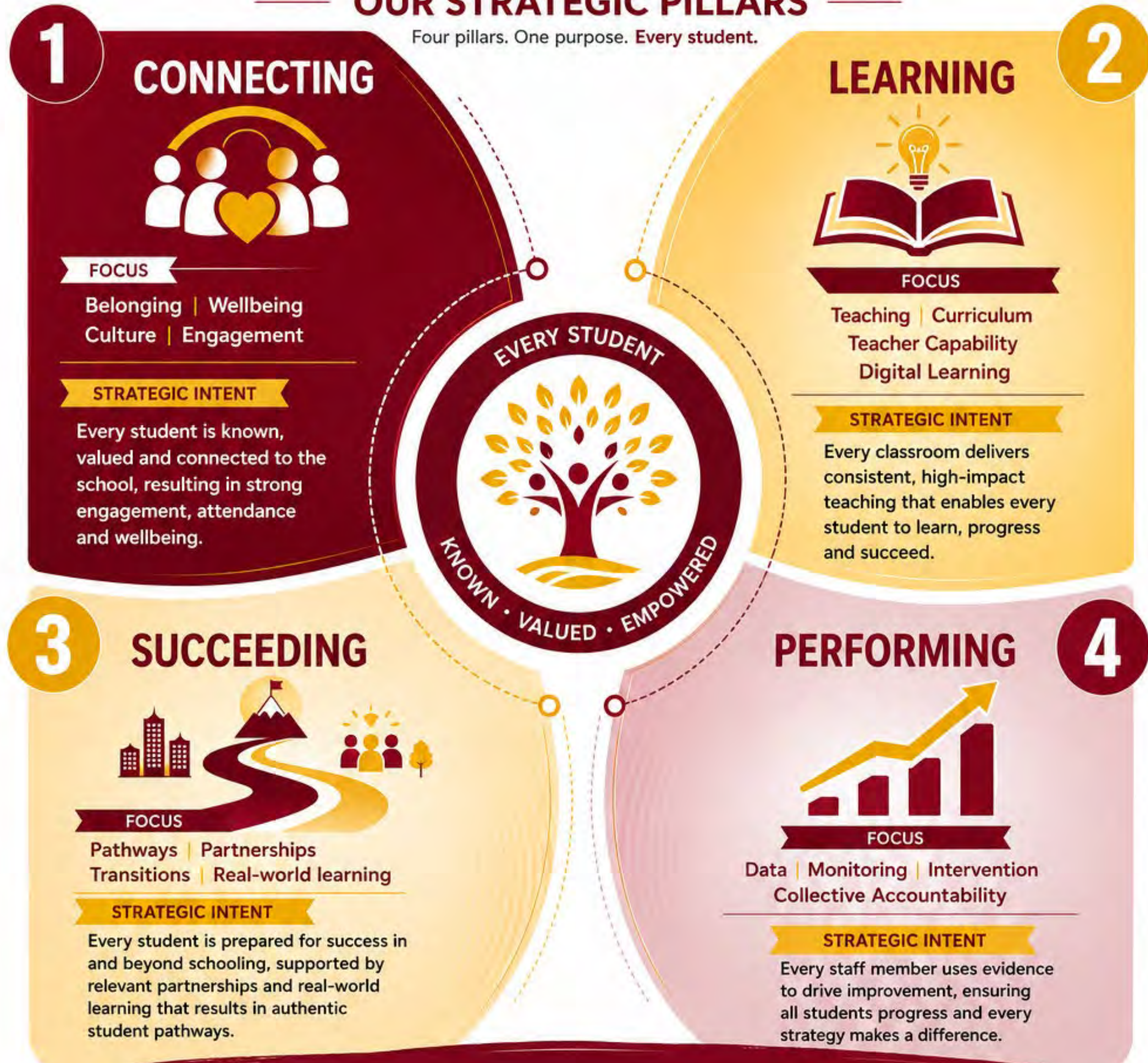

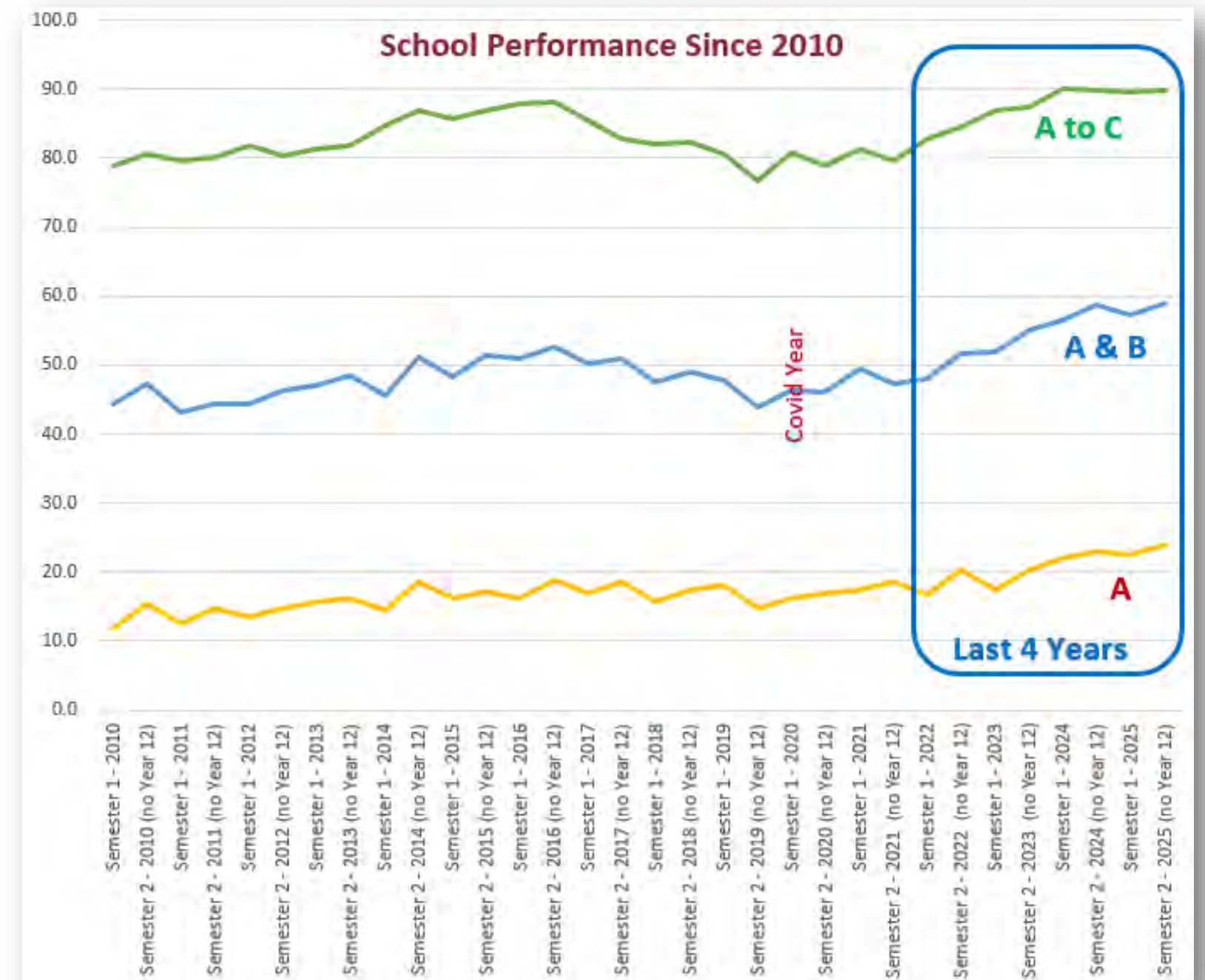


Who Are Our Students? *(2025 Next Step Data)*

- The EMP Committee Reviews all EOIs, as they come in and...
- Eligible enrolments will be sent an offer of enrolment letter with the complete enrolment application package *from 31 July 2026 (Week 3 Term 3)*
- Instructions will be provided to book your enrolment interview (parent and student)
- Successful Signature Program applicants will be notified by mail with the above-mentioned documents *from 31 July 2026* (Week 3 Term 3) – **Delays may occur if additional exam sessions required*
- Parent/Carer and student will attend a group enrolment interview with a member of the Executive Team (1 hour)
- Students with a Disability will have an enrolment interview with Parent/Carer and Head of Learning Enhancement - single student interviews. Inform Enrolment Officer if you need specialised interview by email.
- Check junk email / ensure address is correct at primary school (post and email) and follow Facebook

What if we are unsuccessful?

- Unsuccessful applications will be added to a waiting list in order of receipt
- Unsuccessful letters will be *emailed and posted by the end of Term 3, 2026*
- The waiting list will remain in place for the duration of 12 months
- In-catchment enrolments are processed prior to consideration of any out-of-catchment enrolments.
