Three key strategic focus areas for improvement at Sandgate District State High School from 2018 – 2021 are

- **Curriculum Expertise** - Deepen Knowledge of the standards based Australian Curriculum, assessment and moderation to increase the number of students with valid As, Bs and Cs and increased success in U2B.
- **Improving Writing** - Focus professional learning on writing development through a consistent, school wide approach to the teaching and evaluation of writing with the view to support the Australian curriculum and the effective engagement of students in Senior schooling curriculum.
- **Feedback** - Develop teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching and learning cycle to promote student engagement to improving achievement.

## Our initiatives include

- **Curriculum Expertise** –
  - (1) Provide additional Teacher and Teacher Aide support to students identified as at risk of not meeting NMS and/or minimum C standard in targeted Learning Areas
  - (2) Promote and support professional learning, moderation processes and student engagement in Australian Curriculum through the collaborative learning community known as the B.A.S.E. Cluster
- **Improving Writing** –
  - (1) Target professional learning to writing development focussing on teachers of Years 7,8, 9 and 10.
  - (2) Increase student ability to effectively engage in the senior schooling curriculum from 2019 to 2021.
